Alcohol Policy

Adopted: August 13, 2012

Scope: To provide guidance for the use of alcohol on church property.

Policy: It is the policy of English Lutheran Church of Bateman (ELCB) to permit the use of alcohol, on and in the facilities of ELCB provided that the function is supported by ELCB. The use of alcohol must be discreet, not be accessed by minors, and is consumed as an enhancement to the function where it is served. The Church Council of ELCB reserved the right to evaluate this policy after each function in which alcohol is available.

This policy does not affect the parsonage, nor the grounds of the parsonage.

Procedure: If a designated committee, or group of ELCB wishes to serve alcohol at its function, that committee or group must seek prior approval for alcohol use from the Church Council of ELCB or its designated committee, such as the Executive Committee.
